

## **Creative Residencies 2019**

### **Apply now for a residency at Tanzzentrale der Region Nürnberg e.V.!**

**The application period has started now and will end on march 31<sup>st</sup>, 2019.**

Also in 2019 the Tanzzentrale der Region Nürnberg e.V. is planning to offer Creative Residencies. The scheme is being set up to offer dance artists from Germany and abroad the possibility of working under professional conditions in the studios of the Tanzzentrale. There is also the option to work with dance artists from Nuremberg and region, whether their residency is dedicated to a period of research and development or constitutes the rehearsal phase of a planned project.

In setting up the scheme the Tanzzentrale der Region Nürnberg e.V. aims to enhance the regional dance scene and encourage exchange and dialogue between local dance practitioners and the residency artists. Therefore residency artists will take over the regularly professional practice and at the end of each residency a public showing/rehearsal will take place, which will be advertised in the local and national press and online.

#### **Conditions:**

- Interest in exchange and dialogue between local dance practitioners and public
- Willingness to teach in our professional trainings
- Public work-in-progress-showing at the end of the residency

#### **The Creative Residency scheme includes:**

- duration between 1 and 2 weeks
- using the studio/rehearsal space (dance floor, music and stage equipment)
- subsidy towards travel and accommodation costs
- assist in finding suitable accommodation
- support in Public Relations, organisation and technical equipment
- possibility to attend training
